Welcome back for our last term in Year 3! We have an exciting new topic for this half term; we will be exploring the countries of the world for our geography lessons. We will be using atlases to locate countries around the world before learning more about some countries!

Reading

Practising our word reading and fluency as well as our comprehension and inference skills.

Writing

Based on a wordless picture book, we will be writing a narrative, focusing on direct speech and past tense.

We will then be moving on to do some non-fiction writing before the summer holidays.

Maths

We will be covering fractions, length and perimeter, money, time, shape and statistics. We will learn the key skills and apply these to reasoning and problem-solving questions.

Science

In science, we will be learning about magnets and their uses, as well as plants and their growth before moving on to light and seeing.
